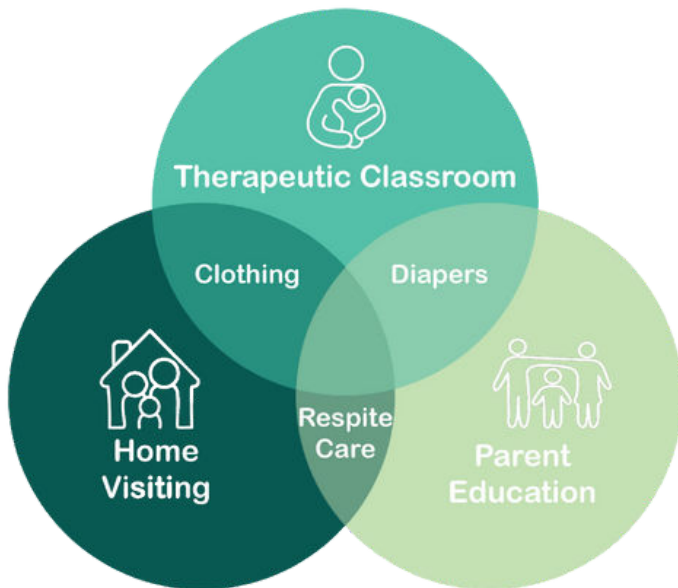
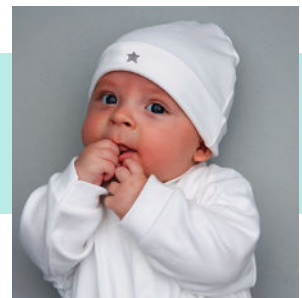


Invest in Relief Nurseries to Strengthen Families & Keep Kids Safe



Your investment in Relief Nurseries supports over 2,300 children and families with home visits, parent education, and therapeutic classrooms at 38 sites across Oregon.

The one-of-a-kind Relief Nursery model provides children, birth through age five, and their families with wraparound support when they need it most.

Over 40 years of experience demonstrate a 95% success rate at preventing unnecessary and costly foster care.

Each Relief Nursery provides a minimum 25% private match for every dollar invested by the State.



FY 23-25 Funding Request

- Support Department of Early Learning and Care **\$5.3 million increase to current service level** to sustain Relief Nursery operations with the increased cost of services, including staff compensation to stabilize the existing workforce, and ensure continued services to over 2,300 children and families.
- Invest **\$15.8 million** to expand services to an **additional 855 children**:
 - 35 new therapeutic classrooms and 21+ new home visitors (\$11.1 million)
 - Four new Relief Nurseries in Coos Bay, Beaverton, Sweet Home, and La Pine (\$2.4 million)
 - Enhance services; transportation, and support staff, increased total compensation (\$2.3 million)
